- they have lost a lot resources and that is why the crimes has been increased
- car theft is up, Hyundai and kias is about 60-70% of vehicles
- 3413 baker street is on the list of places they are actively watching
- 3800-3600 of Minnesota ave is a hot spot where a lot of resources have gone.
- Neighbor Deloris spoke about the shooting on baker, a group of teens were roaming

- Devon spoke about her car getting hit by stray bullet on Monday

- Officer said they can do a speed test at the intersection the intersection of 34 and baker to see if camera can be placed.
- the city rejected our speed bumps and this speed test can get the evidence to get speed bumps as a struggle with ddot.
- we need to contact Vincent gray and tell them, they took our resources to good hope and we need them back
- we have lost man power, admin, over time
- Ayanna asked if there is a way to find crimes in your area. Officer said you can look up dccrimecards in google and it shows crime in your area.
- how are shots reported?
 - if they hit a vehicle
 - if they hit property
 - if they hit a person
 - if there is evidence that the gun was shot
- Deloris spoke about gangs roaming the neighborhood
- officer spoke about how guys are arrested and released so quickly that they are on the streets again and they arrest them so much they know their names. But we need to call the AG and others to change the laws
